**Subject: ODA-CEC Joint Funding**

Two meetings were arranged by Mr. Peter Dun, Counsellor of the British High Commission, on the above cited subject.

The first meeting took place of Mr. Dun's Islamabad residence on July 14 at 1830 hours, attended by:

Since both Aiken and Dun are new to their assignments, they wished to know about the functions and roles of Geneva and Karachi offices. They also discussed AKRSP and wanted to know the background of the fan mail on the activities in Chitral.

The division of funds between ODA and CEC was also discussed.

The second meeting took place at the office of the Community, in which Mr. Tomas'o Sullivan, Representative of CEC participated, in addition to ODA and AKF Representatives

After a thorough discussion, consensus was reached on the division of AKRSP, AKHS and AKES programme components for funding purposes.
