HIGHLIGHTS

1 Cape Town Visit

Annual Trainer's Retreat (ATR) is organized once a year where trainers and seasoned professionals from different walks of life get an opportunity to come together and learn new developments. This year's ATR was held in Cape Town, South Africa from 15 – 19 April, 2012. The theme of this year's conference was Climate Change – A point of Concern. About 70 professionals made this exotic trip to Cape Town. Dr. Rashid Bajwa, Mr. Roomi S. Hayat and several other eminent development professionals delivered thought provoking talks on climate change concerns and how Pakistani development sector can devise mechanism to cope with it.

2 Know About Business

IRM is offering Know About Business (KAB) Entrepreneurship training in collaboration with International Training Center (ITC/ILO Turin, Italy) under the guidance of ITC's seasoned trainers and facilitators. Recently IRM conducted a ten days workshop on "Know about Business – Training of Facilitators" in Karachi. The designed course is particularly relevant for entrepreneurship teachers, lecturers and entrepreneurship course developers. This course will assist participants to better manage their respective vocational centers and become ILO's accredited 'KAB' lecturer.

Summer Internship Programme 2012

IRM in collaboration with HRDN has launched a six-weeks long Summer Internship Programme (SIP). The programme offers internship to 300 interns with an independent research experience under the direct mentorship of established experts in different areas of social and management sciences. It will provide an opportunity to the students to understand the culture of development organizations and gain valuable career related skills.

Meeting with First Women Bank Limited, Islamabad

Three staff members from IRM met with the Head of Business Development & Technical Centers Mrs. Parveen M. Khan. The purpose of the meeting was to identify the areas of collaboration and possible joint ventures especially in enterprise development.

MoU signed with Potohar Steel & Pipe Industry

IRM has signed a Memorandum of Understanding with Potohar Steel & Pipe Industry. As part of the MoU, Potohar Steel & Pipe Industry will employ skilled labor according to the Industry needs from IRM. The said Industry will provide its facilities and expertise to IRM which will impart training to trainees on plumbing, welding, cutting & shaping

steel products and electrician related trades. The MoU was signed on June 13, 2012.

Human Institutional Development

Social Mobilization – Human Institutional Development (SM - HID), funded by PPAF is a capacity building project focused on enhancing the core competencies of NRSP staff to help strengthen the institutional maturity through skill enhancement and knowledge management with social mobilization being the cross cutting theme. A total of 600 Staff members of NRSP belonging to eight different regions will be trained within a time-span of one year i.e. March 2012 – April 2013, in seven different topics; Livelihood Enhancement & Protection, Orientation of Staff, Village Development Plan, Proposal Writing, Enterprise and Business Development, Social Mobilization, Financial Management, Credit Appraisal and Recovery techniques.

IRM organized a Mango Party with full zeal and zest to celebrate the arrival of the mango season. IRM members, ex-staff, alumni members and other worthy guests were present at the event

8 MoU with the University of Bradford (UoB)

As part of the MoU, IRM and UoB have developed a relationship to provide quality education to students in Pakistan. IRM will offer Post-graduate Diploma (PgDip) courses in collaboration with the School of Social and International Studies (SSIS), UoB through distance learning (video conferencing or web-based conferencing) at IRM Islamabad.

Mr. Roomi S Hayat and Dr. Humayun Khan visited SSIS, UoB in June, 2012 and met with Prof. Shaun Gregory, Dr. David Potts and Dr. Hossein Jalilian to discuss the modalities of the proposed partnership. 4 PgDip courses were identified and it was suggested to initiate the courses in September 2013 at IRM, Islamabad.

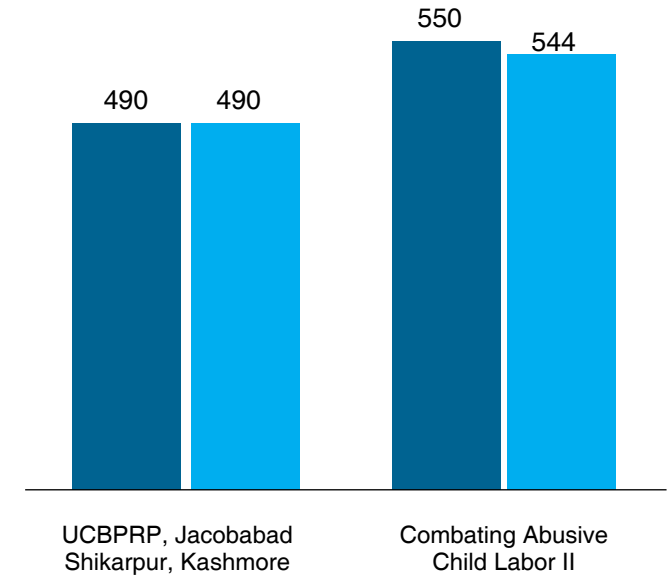

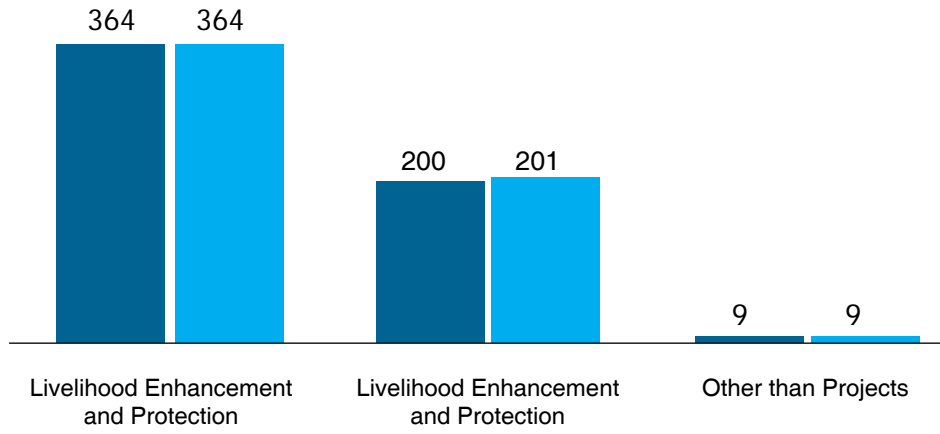

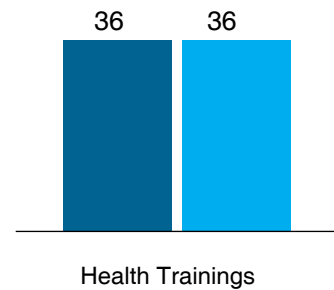

■ Target For June 2012 ■ Achievement of June 2012



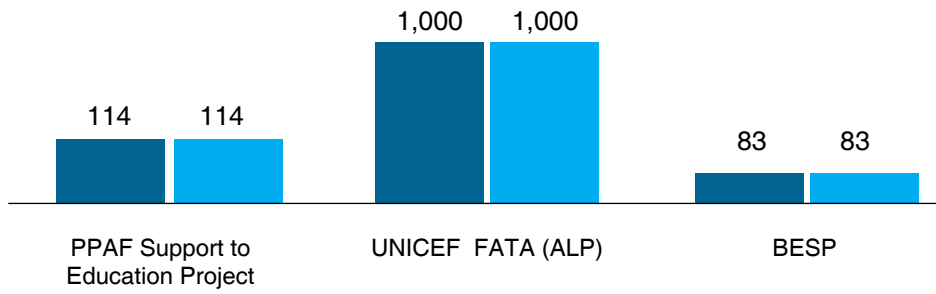

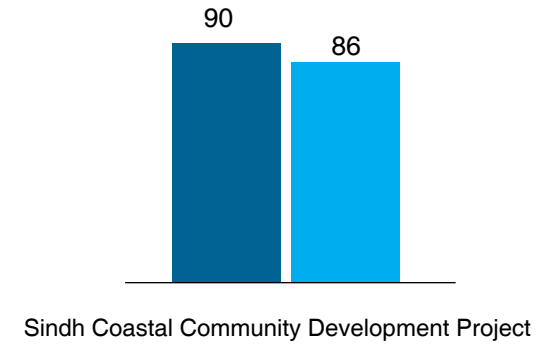

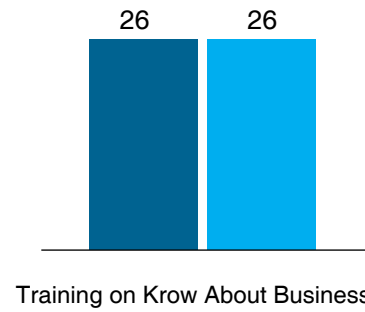
